



Upload status categories

Files sent to the database have an **Upload status**. The **View my transaction history** report shows the status of your transactions for a period you specify. The status categories are explained below.

Upload status	Meaning / Result	Action
BAD FORMAT	The entire file was formatted incorrectly – no animals were transferred. If you upload a BAD FORMAT file, the bad format will be identified immediately and displayed on-screen. Possible causes are missing fields or invalid dates.	Upload a new file containing records in the correct format.
COMPLETE	The file was formatted correctly – all animals were transferred, or the data was processed successfully.	None.
ERROR Example: ERROR 31	The file contained some records with incorrect or invalid data – some animals were not processed. ERRORS may result from mistyped device numbers or PIC numbers but usually occur because data does not comply with database 'rules', such as when you try to transfer an animal recorded as 'Deceased', or an animal already registered to that property. You are not authorised to transfer this animal.	Some ERRORS require further action. If unsure what to do, contact the NLIS Helpdesk.
FAILURE	The file could not be processed at the time you uploaded it. FAILURES may occur if there is a problem with the NLIS database while your file is being processed, or if the time it takes to process the file exceeds the system limit.	None – FAILURES are reprocessed overnight.
INCOMPLETE	The file contained some records with incorrectly-formatted data – some animals were not processed.	Check the format then upload a new file containing <i>only</i> the records not processed in the first upload.
PENDING	The file is in a queue waiting to be processed.	Wait 15 minutes and check again. If still PENDING, contact the NLIS Helpdesk.
PROCESSING	Your file is currently being processed by the database. <u>Note:</u> Processor 'Kill' files are updated in a batch overnight, so the PROCESSING status may be displayed until the next day.	None.
WARNING Example: WARNING 6	Your file was processed – all animals were transferred, but some data was inconsistent with database records. The animal being transferred is not registered to the vendor or PIC you are transferring 'From'.	WARNINGS are usually for information only and rarely require action.
